

<p>New Delhi, the 18<sup>th</sup> September, 1980</p> <p>G.S.R. 1039 – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'A' and 'B' posts in the Civil Aviation Security Organisation, Civil Aviation Department, namely:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Short title and commencement – (1) These rules may be called the Civil Aviation Security Organisation, Civil Aviation Department (Group 'A' and 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1980. (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication to the official Gazette.</li> <li>2. Number of the posts, classification and scale of pay:- The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the Scheduled annexed to these rules.</li> <li>3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc. – The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns t 5 to 13 of the Scheduled aforesaid.</li> </ol>	<p style="text-align: right;">[S. Disqualifications – No person.             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or</li> <li>(b) who having a spouse living as entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible appointment to the said posts.</li> </ol> <p>Provided that the Central Government may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.</p> </li> <li>5. Power to relax – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, after consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provision of the rules in respect of any class or category of persons.</li> <li>6. Saving – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.</li> </ol>
